Bay Area Flu Shot Information: Dial 2-1-1 or 800-273-6222

SAN FRANCISCO, October 17, 2007 – This year, information about flu shots in San Francisco, Napa, Marin, San Mateo and Solano Counties is available from United Way's 2-1-1/HELPLINK call center. The call center can provide information in over 150 languages about where to get flu shots and how much they cost.

Within San Francisco: Dial 2-1-1 in San Francisco, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Outside San Francisco: Callers dialing from outside San Francisco can reach United Way HELPLINK by dialing 415-808-HELP or 800-273-6222 from 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

About United Way HELPLINK and 2-1-1 San Francisco

United Way HELPLINK is a comprehensive, regional Information & Referral system that connects people in need with local community services through its multilingual phone numbers, print directories; and online searchable database. United Way HELPLINK also serves as a vital link for individuals seeking to volunteer or assist during times of crisis.
