Game Changers

1 in 4 Bay Area residents are living in poverty. UWBA works with you to fight against poverty on a scale that no single organization or individual can achieve on its own. We work with adults to help them thrive and ensure families have access to basic needs.

While our work is regional, we address the specific needs of each individual county.
Together, here's how we're changing the odds in Napa County.

Helping Adults Thrive

- In 2017, our *Earn It! Keep It! Save It!* program filed 2,100 tax returns for individuals and families; putting \$2.7 million in refunds back into the community.
- Through our *SparkPoint Napa* center, 30 low-income adults received financial education and career coaching.

Providing Basic Needs

- 345 calls were answered by our 211 *helpline*, resulting in 247 individuals and families connected to housing/shelter, utility, and food assistance,
- Our *Emergency Food & Shelter Program* provided 3,500 meals and 1,400 shelter nights to low-income individuals and families in Napa County.
