<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In 2017, our <i>Earn It! Keep It! Save It!</i> program filed 15,000 tax returns for individuals and families; \$16.5 million was refunded back to the community. - Through our <i>SparkPoint San Francisco</i> center, more than 520 low-income adults received financial education and career coaching. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - More than 6,400 San Francisco County youth were served through our <i>Business Pathways</i> program and the <i>Mayor's Youth Jobs+</i> initiative. - In March 2017, more than 400 youth received professional resume reviews and interview training at the <i>Mayor's Youth Jobs+</i> Resource Fair. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Over 12,500 calls were answered through our <i>211 helpline</i>, resulting in 6,800 individuals and families connected to housing/shelter, utility, and food assistance. - Our <i>Emergency Food & Shelter Program</i> provided 50,000 meals and 4,500 shelter nights to low-income individuals and families in San Francisco County.
