Game Changers

1 in 4 Bay Area residents are living in poverty. UWBA works with you to fight against poverty on a scale that no single organization or individual can achieve on its own. We work with adults to help them thrive and ensure families have access to basic needs.

While our work is regional, we address the specific needs of each individual county.
Together, here's how we're changing the odds in Santa Clara County.

Helping Adults Thrive

- In 2017, our *Earn It! Keep It! Save It!* program filed more than 8,300 tax returns for individuals and families; putting \$7.6 million in refunds back into the community.
- Our *SparkPoint Santa Clara* center provided 160 low-income adults with financial education and career coaching.

Providing Basic Needs

- 20,500 calls were answered by our 211 *helpline*, resulting in 15,300 individuals and families connected to housing/shelter, utility, and food assistance.
- Through the *Emergency Assistance Network* 213 families were assisted with housing, and 90,000 individuals benefitted from food pantries in Santa Clara County.
