




### 2025 Findings

 Clients who receive the Magic Bundle regardless of Race, Parent Status and Student status achieve better financial outcomes with respect to Income and Savings


### Accenture



  - Holistic job training program for individuals seeking employment opportunities in highdemand industries
- Early Care & Education Pathways to Success (ECEPTS)- Associate Teacher Apprenticeship Program
  - Program supports individuals to jump-start their career in ECE while providing holistic support to ensure their success





# >>> Pathways to Thrive

### Phase 1: Stabilization

- Develop individual plans and provide referrals to meet basic needs
- Introduce Financial education to individuals

#### **Phase 2: Discovery**

- Develop employment and training plans
- Start 1:1
   financial &
   Credit
   coaching to
   develop a plan

### Phase 3: Training/Education

- Begin education and training
- Continue to work with Career coach and Financial and Credit coach to achieve goals

#### Phase 4: Employment

- Employment is secure
- Ongoing check-ins with Financial and Credit Coach

- Our financial and credit coaching meets participants where they are and assesses their readiness.
- > Participants have multiple ways to engage with coaches based on their needs.
- > We offer workshops to introduce key financial tools and resources.
- One-on-one coaching is available for those ready to dive deeper into their financial goals.


### **Adults Supporting K-12 Student Success**
